2. Declarations of interest: Nil

3. Planning:

a) Dunham Road development of five houses new application 3PL/2017/0669/F. The council were happy to see that the concerns of the residents and Parish Council had been addressed with this new application as far as the disposal of waste into the main sewer system was concerned. However, it was resolved that the Clerk should comment with regard to the entrance and exit proposals for the development. Due to the narrowness of Dunham Road it was unanimously agreed that a better system would be for the entrance to be at the farthest point from the crossroads with The Street and the exit be at the point closest to the crossroads. Making a one-way system around the five houses rather than two separate entrances, one for three houses the other for two. This was considered important for the safety of other road users as it would be difficult for large vehicles that may have to reverse from the two proposed entrances onto Dunham Road. **Clerk to post comments on Planning application as soon as possible.**

b) 56, The Street 3PL/2017/0884. The plans were discussed at length and it was resolved that no objections would be raised, as not only would the addition improve the view of the house it would also reduce parking on The Street by two vehicles which would be a great help.

4. To approve payments as shown at Annex A:

All agreed, proposed by KM seconded by HD. JB proposed that a further cheque for £100 be written to pay Mr Jamie Stuart for work he had undertaken for the PC at the previous meeting that had now been completed. Seconded by GB, agreed unanimously.

GB handed the Clerk £70.00 in cash that had been sent to him by Mrs Soame as funds raised for the pavilion project from the recent car treasure hunt. On behalf of the PC GB thanked Mrs Soame for efforts to support the pavilion project.
